

Title: Kid Cards **Grade**: PK-1

Overview: Students design their own greeting cards, gift cards, thank you notes, and invitations by choosing messages and decorative stamps. With numerous possibilities, students can be as whimsical or traditional as they like. Cards may be printed so that they can be folded like a card or used as a poster.

My Learning Objectives:

Recognize that meaning is changed when words are changed Understand that print and pictorial images carry meaning

DISCOVER MODE

In Kid Cards, the emphasis is placed upon enjoying and experimenting with words and pictorial symbols to create messages. Children can choose from three types of cards, a variety of messages, and many different picture stamps.

- 1. Click the pencil holder to enter Kid Cards from the Main Room.
- 2. Click the type of card (greeting card, gift card, or invitation) you wish to make.
- 3. Click one of the words or phrases to complete the message and to see and hear it read aloud. If you want a different message, just click a new word or phrase.
- 4. Click the dot before the message to see and hear it read aloud. To hear individual words read aloud, click them.
- 5. Click the arrows to see all of the picture stamps available for your card. (Each word or phrase has a different set of picture stamps.)
- 6. Click the stamp to place it on your card. You can also drag the stamp from the box to any place on the card or from one place to another on the card. To remove a stamp, drag it off the card. Drag as many stamps onto the card as you would like.
- 7. Click the printer to print your card or poster. Then give it to someone special!
- 8. Click the greeting card, gift card, or invitation to make a new card, or click Bailey to return to the Main Room.
